Age: 18 years of age - no maximum age

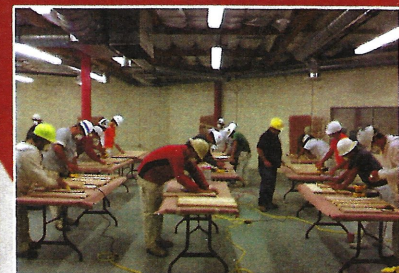
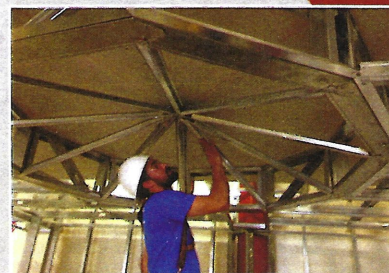
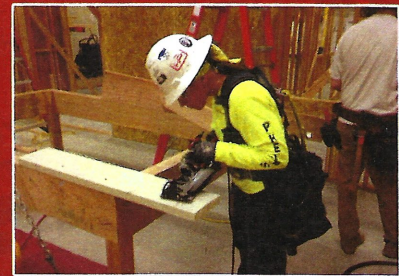
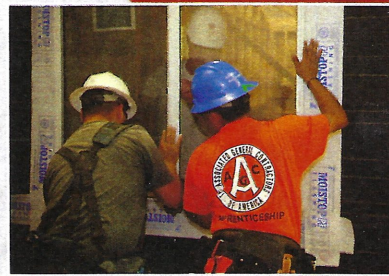
Education: Proof of high school diploma or GED.
